Please NOTE:

- You DO NOT need to complete an out of area form with this application.
- You may apply to multiple schools. All applications are due to respective schools on February 3, 2012.
- At McNair, the Gifted Program is filled on a first-come, first-served basis by gifted eligibility, until our capacity is reached. McNair's Accelerated and Performing Arts Programs are each filled by lottery until enrollment capacity is reached. Lottery window will be February 15-17, 2012.
- Schools will mail notification letters to students selected for Choice Programs on March 2, 2012.
- If more students' Choice applications are received than McNair can accommodate, a waiting list will be established for those who are not selected in the lottery.
- Student names will be pulled from waiting lists as openings become available at Choice Schools/Programs as outlined in District procedures.
- Parents may only sign a commitment letter for only ONE Choice School/Program. The commitment letter is due to the selected school program by 4:00PM on March 23, 2012.
- Students who have submitted more than one commitment letter, will be disqualified from all Choice Schools/Programs and must attend their zoned area school for the year.
- Students must return to their zoned area school if a decision is made not to attend the Choice School or Program (once the commitment letter is submitted). The only exception is if a principal invites a student to attend another Choice School/Program as openings become available.
